3. Review





The review phase of the lesson occurs at the end of the lesson. It is the follow up part of the lesson and is where 1/5 of the time is spent. The emphasis is on students applying the skills and knowledge that was taught in the lesson

The review phase of the lesson is where teachers ensure accurate comprehension.

Students demonstrate they have accurately understood the content or how to apply the content. It is also the part of the lesson where students begin to apply what they have learned to new situations and make **real life applications**.

Teachers check comprehension by engaging the students in a review of the material. This might be done by having students summarize or paraphrase what they have learned.

In order to extend students' thinking beyond the lesson, frequently teachers ask students to apply what they have learned to a real life situation.
